Invoicing schedule is half-yearly in advance. School fees are due with the start of the invoice period or latest with the receipt of the invoice. Late payment penalties may apply. If payment of invoice is made in full within 30 days of invoice date, a discount of 3% on the payable fees under 2.1.1 to 2.2.1 applies.

When transferring the school fees from overseas all bank fees are to be paid for by the payer.

Please be advised that the school fees are set in advance for a calendar year and may change during the period of enrolment if enrolment extends over more than one calendar year, however the school fees for the IB are set at the start of the program and do not change during the 2 year program.
